This training provides an introductory Soil Health course and guidance for those individuals seeking to be certified to write Soil Health Management Plans using Conservation Activity Plan (CAP) 116. Participants will be introduced to soil health planning principles and applicable inventory and evaluation tools to identify specific resource concerns on the land and develop practice recommendations to address those resource concerns.

This virtual training will be hosted by the USDA NRCS Soil Health Division. Registered participants will receive an email with a meeting invitation and further details prior to the training.

Completion of this course will meet the requirements of the CAP 116 which requires completion of NRCS-NEDC-000050 for the ability to write Soil Health Management Plans.
